If you have JMS 1.3.09 and Hikashop 2.1.2 or higher, the multisites functionalities are present and Hikashop is able to filter the categories depending on the website.

You need to setup the JMS Template rule for the Hikashop filtering.

If you have a problem of display of the Hikashop module, verify that you have postions defined in the Joomla module as well as pages on which the module must be displayed and also published the module.
