When we use the word SHARE, this really mean share and not "duplicate with synchronization".  
JMS does NOT duplicate the data.

So if you want to share the content of JomSocial, this is possible with JMS.  
This means that all the #\_\_community\_% tables will be shared except the "config" one.

When you share the content of JomSocial, this also require to share the Joomla users.  
And therefore, the #\_\_user% tables and #\_\_sessions and some other are also shared.

That mean that physically, MySQL will have the same data present in the different websites because the table will be unique in MySQL and not duplicated.

So if you requirement is just to have the JomSocial configuration specific for each site, then yes this is possible as JMS propose a sharing of JomSocial excluding its configuration.
