The smart search is called by joomla a "finder" and not the "search".

The "Multisites Search" plugin works with the "search" (search module) and not with the "finder" (smart search).

I notice the requirement to have a "Multisites finder" (Multisites smart search)

Looking at the source code of the form the name field was wrong, it should be name="jform"

After manualy (and temporary) changed the name of the select field the problem was fixed.

Of course this is not the solution, is there any other way that can we do to permanently fixed the problem? This plugin is very important for our organization and the whole idea of the site will not work if we don't have it.
