The reason is that you have a problem with language files.

Perhaps that they are not installed.

When an extension is installed, normally it should contain the language file that must be deployed by the extension manager.

The words that you can see are the names used by the extension and that are not translated by their real text.

So you have to search why the language file is not found.

In general, in the back-end you should find the language files into
/administrator/language/en-GB/
/administrator/language/en-GB/en-GB.com_phocadownload.ini

In the front-end the language path is
/language/en-GB/en-GB.com_phocadownload.ini
