

## Missing admin user in slave site

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Hello,

I have a problem with login into the slave site.

Used template - zdenka2 (see picture [zd.kvalitne.cz/share/missing\\_admin\\_user/template.png](http://zd.kvalitne.cz/share/missing_admin_user/template.png))

created slave site - slave1.mimino.cz (see picture [zd.kvalitne.cz/share/missing\\_admin\\_user/slavesite.png](http://zd.kvalitne.cz/share/missing_admin_user/slavesite.png))

when slave site has been created from master site Joomla administration page this error has been displayed (see picture [zd.kvalitne.cz/share/missing\\_admin\\_user/error.png](http://zd.kvalitne.cz/share/missing_admin_user/error.png))

DB - slave user tables are shared with master but empty (see picture [zd.kvalitne.cz/share/missing\\_admin\\_user/DB.png](http://zd.kvalitne.cz/share/missing_admin_user/DB.png))

obviously I cannot login into the slave site Joomla administration page (probably because shared user table is empty) (see picture [zd.kvalitne.cz/share/missing\\_admin\\_user/login.png](http://zd.kvalitne.cz/share/missing_admin_user/login.png))

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This means that the user "admin" is not defined in the slave site.

Add in the "Multi Sites User Site" the "admin" user to the slave site "slave1.mimino.cz".

When sharing partially the users, by default the users are not created in the slave site.

You have to grant the permission to access the slave site (including for the admin).

If you had a look with PHPMyAdmin, you should see that there is no user present in the slave 1 website.

Only the users defined with "Multi Site User Site" will be shown in the slave.

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Hi Edwin, thanks for advice. This is better solution that mine :-)  
I have created user from the slave site and assign him admin rights directly in DB (myphpadmin).

I have notices the shared user table in DB is empty after slave creation (only table where users exists is prefix\_multi sites\_user table). And it was weird to me.
