If you have create a website that is located in a directory upper the master website and that you delete this upper directory, this result by deleting all the directories and subdirectories.

This is the only case that we see.

ie: /home/account/public_html/master
and you decide to create a slave site that is located in
/home/account/public_html

When you delete the slave site, this delete the directory
/home/account/public_html
and therefore all the subdirectories (including the /home/account/public_html/master)

To avoid such case, we have recommended an architecture in the tutorial video 0.b slide 21-24 where all the directories are specifics.

This should help you identify the origin of the attack and also have an idea on how he do it.

Hackers may use vulnerabilities in any extension to enter into your websites.

Joomla itself is secured but the extension are less secured.

You have to select extension that have a good security.

Use for example the "black" layout that perfectly works with SEF.
You will find inside different places where the SEF is computed.

Concerning the delete, when the user select a site to delete, this delete this website.
if you have several website deleted simultaneously, you should check the directory structure and verify that you don't have other website in subdirectories.
When you delete a site, this delete the "deployed directory" and of course all the sub-directories.

Whatever the website is a symbolic link or a physical directory, this delete the "deployed directory" AND the `/multisites/{site_id}` (as this is the place where JMS Multisites saves the site definition).

So you have to be sure that the deployed directory is not a directory that contain sub sites.

See iin the "Manage site" definition and not inside the PHP code generated.

I suspect that you let the field empty in the "manage site".

Check the "deploy folder" parameter.

Here you have specified plenty of links to created and I don't know which is the template definition.

All I can see is that you are probably working with Plesk and that the domain that you specified is very strange as it does not contain any Top Level Domain.

You have specified www.domain

I will try reproducing similar scenario.

Just a comment in the meantime, based on your PHP description, I see that you have let definition for Symbolic Link and not have specified the deployed directory.

Perhaps you could "ignore" all the directories defined in the JMS Templates as you don't have to create any link as you decide to use the same directory as the master. (Deployed direct = empty)

Something that seems strange.

You seems mentioned that you used this JMS Templates to create website from the front-end and you don't have selected any Template Site for the replication.

In addition, the list of domains that you have specified does not seems contain any "{site_prefix}" or similar to compute the domain based on the parameters entered in the front-end.

So I don't know if this is the rule that you provide to the front-end to create slave site that are deleting all the directories.

The scenario that you described seems inconsistent.

Would you please rewrite the complete scenario that we have to reproduce and that highlight your problem.

Does the problem occurs when deleting a slave site created from the front-end or when deleting a slave site from the back-end.

Template is a fresh installatin & hasn't any {} site_id indomain definition. The definition domain is
subdomain.domain.com

Slave has domain definition www.domain.com/multisites/{site_id}

All temaplates & all slaves have the same estructure

The big problem is We can't to reproduce the scenario deleting in front or back-end because the sites
are delete sometimes (look like ramdom) but y suspect tha is in front-end because nobody except me
can delete sites in back-end.
